

Volunteer Activity	Point Value	Volunteer Activity Description Specific Dates of events can be found online.
Coach	100	Co-coach team and follow season program. Coach Development dates to be determined. Please make sure to choose the appropriate age group and time.
Field Condition Monitor	100	Determine the weather condition and update teams on game or practice cancellations. Please make sure to choose the appropriate Day of Play. i.e. if you choose Tuesday/Thursday you will be in charge of all teams playing on those days regardless of age group registered in.
Age Group Manager	100	Be point of contact between Soccer Coordinator and Age Group Coordinators.
Age Group Coordinator	100	Be point of contact for coaches and managers throughout the season. Web-based e-mail program is used to communicate with coaches. Please make sure to choose the appropriate age group.
Volunteer Coordinator	100	Manages the volunteers required for the season. Recruit coaches for the season prior to season start. Completes the final Volunteer list at the end of the season.
Team Formation	100	Create teams using Excel. Experience with Microsoft Excel is required.
Team Formation Coordinator	100	Enter completed teams into the database. Works with age group coordinators to shuffle teams prior to season start, if necessary.
Registrar	100	Coordinates and supervises the registration committee. Ensures all registrations are complete and submitted correctly.
Registration Team Member	100	Works to process player registrations.
Picture Coordinator	100	Coordinates all aspects of the Soccer Pictures including photographer, volunteers and distribution.
Inventory Manager	100	Coordinates the collection of the equipment at the end of the season.
Equipment Coordinator	100	Coordinates the distribution of equipment prior to season start. Ensures all teams have the appropriate equipment.
Medal Coordinator	100	Coordinates the distribution of medals prior to the end of season.
Police Check Coordinator	100	Coordinates police check sessions with approved members of the TCA board. Ensures all coaches have submitted their paperwork.
First Aid Coordinator	100	Contacts first aid volunteers, sets up training and assigns volunteers to fields.
BBQ Coordinator	100	Coordinates season-end BBQ.
BBQ Volunteer Coordinator	100	Contacts, schedules and manages BBQ volunteers for BBQ.
BBQ Coordination Committee	100	Plans wrap up BBQ with key volunteers.
Donation Coordinator	100	Coordinates year-end collection of un-wanted soccer equipment.
Game Scheduler	50	Creates the game and practice schedules for the age group. Experience with Microsoft Excel is required. Please make sure to choose the appropriate age group.
Pre-Season Equipment Distribution	50	This will require a 2-4 hour commitment to sort and assemble team equipment for distribution. Individuals with large vehicles and/or air compressors are asked to bring them on the Friday evening so the equipment can be retrieved from storage and the balls can be inflated. Sorting will take place on the Friday evening and distribution will take place on the Saturday.
Team Manager	50	Helps coach collect and return equipment at the start and end of season. Is the lead contact for all team functions including practices and games. Overall reduces any administrative work for the coaches. Please make sure to choose the appropriate age group and time.

Picture Volunteer	50	Various duties regarding pictures. Can include organization, picture day and picture delivery.
Inventory	50	This will require a 1-2 hour commitment to sort and assemble team equipment for inventory and storage. Individuals with large vehicles are asked to bring them so the equipment can be returned to storage.
First Aid	50	Must have a valid first aid course and be able to call for and direct emergency help to the field area. Must be available most days of play. If necessary a first aid course will be provided for volunteers. If you are currently certified please provide proof with registration. Please make sure to choose the appropriate age group and time.
Field Equipment Coordinator	50	Completes pre-season and/or post-season inventory and maintains equipment in storage boxes during the season.
BBQ Volunteers	50	Various duties prior and during BBQ. The following may be needed for the BBQ; please indicate on your registration form if you can help out. 2 propane tanks to run the BBQ rented from ATCO Gas truck to pick up and drop off rented BBQ from ATCO Gas 2 men to lift and ties to secure BBQ
